

CITY OF MOAB RESOLUTION NO. 24-2019
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF JOEL LINARES TO THE
POSITION OF CITY MANAGER AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE
AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

The following describes the intent and purpose of this resolution:


- a. The City Council has engaged in a hiring process involving interviews for the position of City Manager, to be filled upon the planned departure of the current City Manager, David Everitt.
- b. As a result of that hiring process the City Council has determined that Assistant City Manager Joel Linares is the best candidate for the position.
- c. It is necessary to fill the position of City Manager effective August 2, 2019, following the expiration of the current City Manager's contract.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council resolves as follows:

1. Joel Linares shall be appointed to the position of City Manager, subject to the terms of an employment contract between the City and Mr. Linares.
2. The Council authorizes the Mayor to sign an employment contract with Mr. Linares having a term of not to exceed three (3) years; with a salary of not to exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) per year; and providing that employment shall at all times be at-will, and subject to the discretion of the City Council. The contract shall provide for periodic reviews of performance, and that the compensation of the employee may be adjusted based upon performance.
